History: I bought the car in 1993, it was very neglected and in a poor condition having been stored for 15 years. TS 20076-0 was built to order at Standard Motors Coventry, on Wednesday, 10 July, 1957, (see attached build certificate) for a customer in the U.K. It was painted Pearle White, with Vermilion leather trim, overdrive, and competition springs and shock absorbers. Since the rebuild it has travelled to numerous National gatherings around South Africa, to Cape Town on 2 occasions, twice to the Eastern Cape, to Bloemfontein, and KZN every year. Modifications are rack and pinion steering, racing seats, electronic ignition, electric cooling fan, an oil cooler, aluminum sump and Alfin rear brake drums.
